

Incomplete Grade Form

Policy Information

- A grade of incomplete or "I" may be issued when course requirements have not been satisfied because of the student's extenuating circumstances. The student must have completed at least 50% of the course curriculum requirements for a grade of "I" to be issued.
- A student may petition the instructor for time beyond the end of the semester to finish the work. This petition must include supporting documentation to support the student's justification for an extension.
- The student is required to complete the coursework by the end of the following semester or the incomplete grade will be converted to a grade of "F."
