## EDUCATIONAL EXPERIENCE PROGRAM PROGRAM AGREEMENT

## RECITALS

WHEREAS, it is agreed by the parties hereto to be of mutual interest and advantage that students and faculty of the University be given the opportunity to utilize the Facility for educational purposes:

NOW THEREFORE, the parties to this Agreement agree as follows:

The students receiving clinical experience in Health Informatics will be individuals enrolled in the graduate program.

The students will be in the Facility during the regular academic period defined in the University's catalog for each year and will be under the supervision of a faculty member of the University.

The Facility shall at all times be in charge of the services it provides to its clients.

The names of students and period of assignment will be furnished to the Facility by the University.

The number and distribution of students between the divisions of the Facility will be mutually agreed upon between the University and Facility.

Faculty and students will be subject to the rules and regulations established by the Facility to which they are assigned.

Students will be responsible for their own transportation, meals, laundry and health care needs in the performance of this Agreement. There will be no exchange of monies between the Facility and the University.

The Facility agrees to provide the University the necessary space for facilities for conference and classroom areas for students, as available. The Facility also agrees to provide locker space and lounge areas for students, as available. The Facility also agrees to allow students and faculty to utilize the Facility eating facilities at the students' and faculty's expense.

The University agrees that members of the faculty may serve as consultants and on committees of the Facility when requested by the Facility.
